Dancewear Boys/Men

Ballet (Junior/Intermediate Level)

Black short sleeve leotard

Black cotton/Lycra leggings (no stirrups)

Tap & Jazz (Junior)

Dancewear as for ballet

Tap shoes: black patent low heel oxford

toe & heel taps attached (no lip or "jingle" taps)

Jazz shoes: black leather jazz oxfords with laces

Grooming – hair well combed

Ballet (Intermediate/Senior/Advanced Level)

Black or white short-sleeve leotard

Black men's weight tights

Men's dance support belt

White ankle socks

Black leather pleated shoes with elastic attached as required by the school

Grooming – hair well combed

Tap & Jazz (Intermediate/Senior/Advanced Level)

Black or white short-sleeve leotard

Black cotton/Lycra leggings (no stirrups) or bike shorts

Men's dance support belt

Tap shoes: black leather low heel oxford

toe & heel taps attached (no lip or "jingle" taps)

Jazz shoes: black leather jazz oxfords with laces

Grooming – hair well combed

Hip Hop (All Levels)

Black or white t-shirt, plain, no printed design

Black track pants or shorts, plain no printed design

Black sport sock

Jazz shoes: black leather jazz oxfords with laces (Junior/Intermediate)

Black "bloc" low rise jazz sneakers (Senior)

Dance Gymnastics (All Levels)

Since most gym classes coincide with the ballet program, ballet dancewear should be worn

Capezio brand "Foot undies" or comparable studio approved brand

Grooming – hair well combed

Special Notice

Warm up wear (such as leg warmers) is not permitted in any classes.

Warm up cross over cardigans will be provided by the school to classes during cold weather if necessary.

Please do not delay classes commencing by wearing T-shirts, etc. into the classroom.

All new shoes should be brought to the school & checked before they are worn or elastic sewn on (soiled shoes cannot be returned). We cannot accept responsibility of children in class with poor fitting shoes. Damage & restricted progress can occur to the feet, especially if the shoes are “too” large.

All students must have correct dancewear & shoes for all classes. If you purchase dancewear outside the studio, please check items with Miss Carter before wearing them. Shoes that vary in colour or tone, heel height or design, or dancewear varying in cut, style or colour cannot be worn for class, examinations or performance. Great care is often taken to detail all aspects of a recital costume only to have students mismatched footwear from the overall effect.
